

MINDFULNESS RETREAT The Salt Marsh Sangha invites you to a mindfulness retreat in the tradition of Thich Nhat Hanh. The retreat is residential with silent sitting meditation, indoor and outdoor walking meditation and daily Dharma talks by our teacher, Dharma discussions, and Sutra services. The retreat is suitable for beginning and experienced meditation practitioners.



Our teacher Leslie Rawls is a Dharmacharya (Dharma Teacher) in the Order of Interbeing. She received Lamp Transmission from the Venerable Thich Nhat Hanh during the 2008-2009 Winter Retreat in Plum Village, France. In 1995 Thich Nhat Hanh ordained Leslie as a lay Buddhist minister in the core community of the Order of Interbeing with the Dharma name, True Realm of Enlightenment.

Leslie has studied Buddhism since 1970, but her study did not become a living practice until she encountered Thich Nhat Hanh. Leslie has a husband and 2 adult children. She teaches mindfulness meditation weekly in a prison. One Dharma Teacher describes her as "articulate, insightful, and extremely kind."



Retreat Logistics

Date and Time: Please arrive between 5:00 and 6:00pm on Friday, Sept 25th. The retreat ends at 3:00pm Sunday, Sept 28th.

Registration: Registration opens Aug 1st, 2014 and closes Sept 18th, 2014. Space is limited so please register early. Registering early greatly supports retreat planning efforts.

Setting: Our retreat will be on a historic property and former plantation on the Eastern Shore of Virginia, a few miles northwest of Eastville. After you have registered, you will receive detailed driving instructions.

Lodging: A variety of accommodations are available. You may bring a tent or camper. Indoor accommodations include beds or a mattress or pad on the floor. Please bring your own bedding and towels.

Retreat Costs: Early registration (before Sept 5th) costs \$85.00. After Sept 5th, the cost is \$100.00. This amount covers food for retreat participants and transportation for Leslie. No one is turned away due to inability to pay.
